FROM THE PASTOR'S PEN

Dear Members of Central:

March is a special time for me as a pastor and a sports fan. One of the greatest sports spectacles takes place in March of each year and its called "March Madness." The Gallants were long time members of our church and their daughter Carol Gallant has funded the scholarship in their honor. The scholarship is given to the recipient for four consecutive years provided the student maintains acceptable grades in their field of study.
