It was so good to see many of your faces (with a mask on) this past Sunday as we reopened the church and resumed our in-person worship service. Unfortunately, we are returning back to “Virtual Worship” service for the remainder of this month due to malfunction of the sanctuary AC system. The AC system was down this past Sunday and it was quite warm in the sanctuary, but the fan was still working. The repair of the AC system will require shutting down the fan as well, which means there will be lack of air circulation in the sanctuary, along with uncomfortable temperature. The repair process will last 2 to 3 weeks, which means we will not be able to use it for remainder of this month. We thought about using the Family Life Center (FLC) for Sunday worship service, but the logistics problems would be too much to handle for an abbreviated service. **Therefore, we are returning to “Virtual Worship” service on our YouTube page on Sunday mornings for remainder of July.** As I pray about God’s hand and discernment of the Spirit in this matter, I am reminded that we are still in the midst of a COVID-19 pandemic and despite our preparations to mitigate the spread of this virus, waiting several more weeks to resume in-person worship service isn’t such a bad thing.
