FROM THE PASTOR'S PEN

Dear Members of Central:

as Ash Wednesday will be on February 26. A little history on the Season of Lent...

The Lenten season developed as part of the historical Christian calendar and is typically celebrated by Catholics and some mainline Protestant churches that follow a liturgical calendar. Although its format has varied throughout the centuries and throughout different cultures, the basic concept remains the same... to open our hearts to God's refining grace through prayer, confession, fasting, and offering as we anticipate the Holy Week.

We are at the door step of the Lenten Season

Let me share with you the essence of this important season on the Christian calendar. Similar to the Advent Season, Lent is a time to draw closer to our God, so that when Good Friday and eventually Easter comes, it is not just another day at church but an opportunity to receive God's overflowing grace. Lent is an intensely penitential time as we examine our sinful natures and return to God seeking His forgiveness and mercy, which He surely bestows upon us as we seek Him with genuine, submissive and humble hearts... full of repentance. Lent is also an opportunity to contemplate what our Lord really did for us on the Cross. How much He suffered for us so that we can be redeemed in our relationship with God as His children.

Here are some practical encouragements for

all of you as you begin this Lenten Season...

- Use a good Lenten Devotional... there are so many out there and you can get free ones online.
- Spend each day in reading of God's Word and also in time of prayer.
- Keep a Lenten Journal so that you can reflect on your time with God during this spiritual season.
- Meet up with others in order to encourage them and also be accountable to them... form of spiritual fellowship with one another.

Here is a wonderful passage from the Bible that is very helpful for us as we prepare for Lent. Philippians 3:8~11... "Indeed, I count everything as loss because of the surpassing worth of knowing Christ Jesus my Lord. For his sake I have suffered the loss of all things and count them as rubbish, in order that I may gain Christ and be found in him, not having a righteousness of my own that comes from the law, but that which comes through faith in Christ, the righteousness from God that depends on faith—that I may know him and the power of his resurrection, and may share his sufferings, becoming like him in his death, that by any means

possible I may attain the resurrection from the dead."

The Central Steele Creek Presbyterian Church Scholarship was started in 1984 as a tribute to her memory. The award is made yearly and only the interest is used to finance the scholarship with the principal remaining untouched. Additional donations are gratefully accepted as the cost of a college education continues to rise.

The Pete and Gertrude Gallant Memorial Scholarship was established in 2014. The Gallants were long time members of our church and their daughter Carol Gallant has funded the scholarship in their honor. The scholarship is given to the recipient for four consecutive years provided the student maintains acceptable grades in their field of study.


