Greetings to Central Church family & friends.

These are very difficult and challenging times for humanity as we struggle with the COVID-19 pandemic in this country and all over the world. The outbreak of this virus has overwhelmed our healthcare institutions and all medical and healthcare professionals are stretched thin in their ability to provide care for the patients. It's not just the COVID-19 patients that are struggling, but other people with medical conditions are also suffering as their surgeries and treatments are being delayed and/or canceled due to greater focus on this pandemic. We have church members who need surgeries and medical care, but their appointments are in limbo at this time. Just about everything that requires gathering of 10 or more people have been canceled, including all schools in Charlotte.
